Topic: Past Continuous

Past continuous – czas przeszły niedokonany. Zdanie składa się:

Osoba + was/were+ czasownik z końcówką „ing”.

I was reading a book – ja czytałam książkę.

She was reading a book – ona czytała książkę.

They were reading a book – oni czytali książkę.

Zdania pytające:

Was/were + osoba + czasownik z „ing”

Was she reading a book?

Yes, she was.

No, she wasn't.

Zdania przeczące:

Osoba + wasn't/weren't + czasownik z “ing”.

They weren't reading a book.

Ex.6/55

1 were hanging

2 was filming

3 were eating

4 was playing

5 were looking

Ex. 7/55

2 George and Harry weren't making sandwiches. They were making popcorn.

3 Emma wasn't using a blender. Emma was using a toaster.

4 Gran wasn't looking for her glasses. She was looking the remote control.
